

- Attend and actively participate in all sessions and activities sponsored by the SERC-NAHRO Youth Leadership Conference. Only the most extenuating circumstances will excuse a member from activities.
- Conduct yourself in a professional manner at all times. Treat program areas, lodging areas, and transportation vehicles with respect and care when participating in any Housing Authority of Columbus sponsored event. Be responsible for any damage, theft, or misconduct.
