

J.P. Lawrence Memorial Bus Tour

*In Memory of J. P. Lawrence, SERC is providing

This memorial tour honoring "J. P."

will be limited to the first 50 people registering for the tour.

Following Hurricane Katrina, Mississippi Regional Housing Authority No. VIII created South Mississippi Housing and Development Corporation, a non-profit instrumentality, to respond to the increased need for affordable housing along the Mississippi Gulf Coast. Using a variety of financial resources, including housing tax credits, tax-exempt bonds, and HUD-appropriated funds, MRHA VIII, SMHD, and their development partners constructed over 1000 affordable housing units.

Two of the tax-credit properties built following Hurricane Katrina, The Estates at Juan de Cuevas (2008), and Timber Grove (2009), are located in D'Iberville, MS.

The Estates at Juan de Cuevas, located at 10472 Gorenflo Rd., is a multifamily development consisting of eight residential buildings totaling 120 units.



Timber Grove, located at 10687 Auto Mall Pky, is a multifamily development consisting of four residential buildings totaling 96 units.

These properties were developed under the leadership of the late Mr. J. P. Lawrence, Executive Director/CEO MRHA VIII. Many families' dreams live on through his legacy. Mr. Lawrence died January 9, 2016.
